It has been more than 20 years since a traffic officer, specifically, was assigned at the intersection of Brattle Street and JFK Street (at the time called Boylston Street) to direct traffic. In recent memory, the walking officers assigned to the routes in Harvard Square would congregate at that location (Box 56) rather than patrol their entire respective route. Following repeated requests from the residents, merchants and the Harvard Square Business Association that walking officers were not visible throughout the Square, officers were directed to stay on their respective route, walk the entire route, and not congregate at one location.

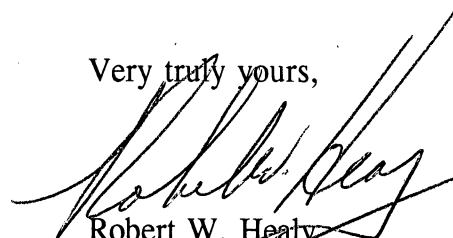
