- WHEREAS: Henry worked diligently in this assignment until 1975 at which time he was appointed as the Safety Officer, a position requiring skill and the ability to deal not only with adults, but with children of all ages, a job he truly enjoyed; and
- WHEREAS: Henry will be truly missed by his many friends, colleagues and school children, to whom he has become attached over the years; now therefore be it
- RESOLVED: That this City Council go on record extending its sincere appreciation and gratitude to Officer Henry Jason on the occasion of his retirement; and be it further
