To The Honorable, The City Council:

Attached is an order requesting the appropriation of funds from the settlement of a case for \$40,000 to the Police Extraordinary Expenditure Account to provide funds for renovations to an area on the first floor of the Police Station for a locker room and shower facility for female Police Officers. The proposed facility would include up to 30 individual lockers, two sinks, two toilets and one shower.

This money was recovered by the City through its involvement in a federal case against an employee of the greater Boston Police Council, who embezzled funds from the purchase of radio equipment made by the City.
