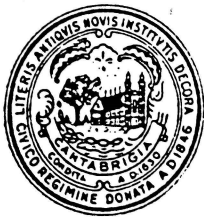

c. City Council Member, thirty-nine thousand five hundred dollars (flat rate).

2. The effective date of these rates shall be July 1, 1996.

3. Effective July 1, 1997, the above positions shall receive an additional increase of four percent of the salary of July 1, 1996. Effective July 1, 1998, the above positions shall receive an additional three and one-half percent of the salary of July 1, 1997. 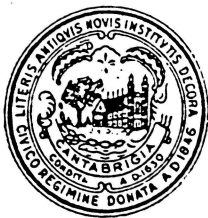

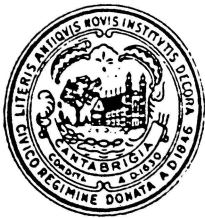

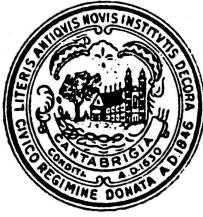
