- WHEREAS: The Cambridge School Department in conjunction with the Eastern Middlesex Human Resource Development Authority has applied for funding under the Youth Entitlement Project for a pilot project, STAY (Special Transitional Activities for Youth), and
- WHEREAS: Project STAY would bring \$956,357 to the Cambridge School Department for youth employment and
- WHEREAS: The project would provide on-the-job training and skills development for drop-out and drop-out potential high school youth in Area 4 of Cambridge, and
- WHEREAS: This program provides an innovative and effective means to address the needs of economically disadvantaged and under-educated youth of ages 16 through 19, enabling them to compete more successfully in today's job market, now therefore be it
- RESOLVED: That this City Council go on record urging Senator Edward Brooke to support the Youth Incentive Entitlement Pilot Project STAY.
