



To the Honorable, the City Council:

The attached appropriation transfers, totalling \$187,000, has been requested by the Assistant City Manager for Community Development and the Commissioner of Public Works in order to expand the City's Block Grant Streets and Sidewalks Rehabilitation program. Funds for this expanded program are available from unexpended/unencumbered balances in two other Block Grant accounts. The first of these is the Block Grant contingency, \$139,200; the second is the East Cambridge Fire Station, \$47,800. As you may recall, the 1975/76 Block Grant application contained an authorization of \$430,000 for the East Cambridge Fire Station.

Of this authorization, we have used \$382,200, broken out as follows:

| <u>Expenditure Type</u> | <u>Amount</u>     |
|-------------------------|-------------------|
| Site Survey/Appraisal   | \$ 2,900          |
| Architect               | 89,550            |
| Land Taking             | 279,750           |
| Relocation              | 10,000            |
| Total                   | <u>\$ 382,200</u> |

Passage of the attached orders is recommended.
