Petition of Middlesex & Boston Street Railway Co. for a certificate of public convenience and necessity for the operation of motor vehicles for the carriage of passengers for hire over certain public ways in the City of Cambridge and Towns of Weston, Lincoln, Concord, Acton, Maynard, Stow, Arlington, Belmont, Lexington, and over a route between Watertown Square and Five Forks - Lexington in Towns of Watertown, Belmont, Arlington and Lexington over the following routes:

MAYNARD TO HARVARD SQ., CAMBRIDGE

WESTON

North Avenue (Route 117) between the ^{opposite} turnaround Drabington Lodge and the Lincoln town line. _A

LINCOLN

South Great Road (Route 117) between the Weston town line and Codman Road
 Codman Road between South Great Road and Concord Road
 Concord Road (Route 126) between Codman Road and the Concord town line.

CONCORD

Walden Street (Route 126) between the Lincoln town line and Heywood Street
 Heywood Street (Route 126) between Walden Street and Lexington Road
 Lexington Road between Heywood Street and Main Street
 In and around Monument Square
 Main Street (Route 62) between Sudbury Road and the Acton town line
 Thoreau Street between Main Street and Sudbury Road
 Sudbury Road between Thoreau Street and Main Street.

ACTON

Powder Mill Road (Route 62) between the Concord town line and the Maynard town line.

MAYNARD:

Powder Mill Road (Route 62) between the Acton town line and Parker Street

Parker Street between Powder Mill Road and Great Road
Great Road between Parker Street and the Stow town line
Main Street between Great Road and Waltham Street
Waltham Street between Main Street and Parker Street
Walnut Street between Parker Street and Main Street
River Street between Main Street and Walnut Street
Summer Street between Main Street and Nason Street
Nason Street between Summer Street and Main Street
Sudbury Street between Main Street and Great Road.

STOW

Great Road (Route 62) between the Maynard town line and Gleasondale Road

Gleasondale Road (Route 62) between Great Road and the Hudson town line.

CAMBRIDGE

Peabody Street between Massachusetts Avenue and Cambridge Street.
Cambridge Street between Peabody Street and Massachusetts Avenue
Massachusetts Avenue between Cambridge Street and Peabody Street
Garden Street between Massachusetts Ave. and Concord Avenue.
Concord Avenue between Garden Street and Alewife Brook Parkway.
Alewife Brook Parkway (Route 2) between Concord Avenue and the Concord Turnpike.

Concord Turnpike (Route 2) between Alewife Brook Parkway and the Arlington town line.

Concord Turnpike (Route 2) between the Arlington town line and the Arlington and Belmont town lines.

ARLINGTON AND BELMONT

Concord Turnpike (Route 2) between the Cambridge city line and the Cambridge city line.

Concord Turnpike (Route 2) between the Cambridge city line and Park Avenue.

LEXINGTON

Concord Turnpike (Route 2) between Spring Street and the Lincoln town line.

Watertown Street between Concord Turnpike and Pleasant Street.
Pleasant Street between Watertown Street and Massachusetts Avenue.

Marrett Road (Route 2A) between Massachusetts Avenue and Spring Street.

Middle Street between Marrett Road and Lincoln Street.

Lincoln Street between Middle Street and Massachusetts Avenue.

LEXINGTON (cont.)

School Street between Marrett Road and Massachusetts Avenue.
Massachusetts Avenue (Route 2A) between Access Road and the
Lincoln town line.

LINCOLN

Concord Turnpike (Route 2) between the Lexington town line and
the Concord town line.
North Great Road (Route 2A) between the Lexington town line and
the Concord town line.
Concord By-pass between North Great Road and the Concord town
line.

CONCORD

Concord By-pass between the Lincoln town line and Main Street.
Cambridge Turnpike (Route 2) between the Lincoln town line and
Concord By-pass.
Lexington Road (Route 2A) between the Lincoln town line and
Heywood Street.

WATERTOWN SQ. TO FIVE FORKS * LEXINGTON

WATERTOWN

Mt. Auburn Street between Main Street (Beacon Square) and
Common Street.
Common Street between Mt. Auburn Street and Orchard Street.
Orchard Street between Common Street and Belmont Street.
Sycamore Street between Belmont Street and the Belmont town line.

BELMONT

Sycamore Street between the Watertown town line and Lexington
Street
Waverly Street between Trapelo Road and Common Street.
Common Street between Waverly Street and Concord Avenue.
Concord Avenue between Common Street and Leonard Street.
Leonard Street between Concord Avenue and Pleasant Street.
Pleasant Street (Route 60) between Leonard Street and the
Arlington town line including the ramps and that portion of
Lake Street within the ramps connecting Pleasant Street with
the Concord Turnpike (Route 2).

ARLINGTON

Pleasant Street (Route 60) between the Belmont town line and
Massachusetts Avenue including the ramps connecting Pleasant
Street with the Concord Turnpike (Route 2).
Massachusetts Avenue between Mill Street and Franklin Street
Franklin Street between Massachusetts Avenue and Broadway.
Broadway between Franklin Street and Massachusetts Avenue.
Mill Street between Massachusetts Avenue and Summer Street.
Summer Street between Mill Street and the Lexington town line.

LEXINGTON

Summer Street Extension (Route 2A) between the Arlington town line and Lowell Road.

Lowell Road between Summer Street Extension and Woburn Street.

Woburn Street between Lowell Road and Massachusetts Avenue.
