A meeting was held between the residents and businesses located on Fulkerson Street to determine the effect of making this street one way had on the neighborhood.

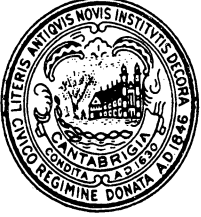
The residents think it has cut down on the noise and traffic and the business community claimed a severe hardship in traveling 2 or 3 extra blocks to reach their plant.

After listening to all the suggestions and checking the area periodically, it was our recommendation that Fulkerson Street be made one way from Cambridge Street to Charles Street and two way from Charles Street to Binney Street. Both parties agreed that this would assist the business community and still maintain the one way pattern in the residential area.

The Traffic Department will implement this plan along with the proper signing as soon as possible

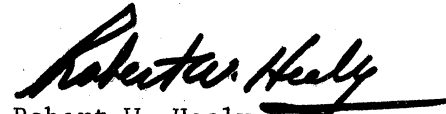
