IN CITY COUNCIL

September 30, 1974

ORDERED:

That the Commissioner of Public Works be and hereby is authorized to grant a permit to Minute Man Engineering Corporation of Lincoln, Mass. to erect a barricade on the sidewalk in front of the premises numbered 28-36 Brattle Street for a period of two months commencing October 1, 1974 during the erection of a new building at the premises numbered 28-36 Brattle Street.

Said permit to be granted subject to the following conditions:

1. A barricade constructed of steel staging with a roof of sturdy wooden construction to be erected in the public way suitably lighted as to prevent any injury to pedestrians using this street.
2. Said obstruction to occupy the entire sidewalk at said premises.
3. The contractor to restore existing sidewalk to the condition it was prior to the construction or to a better condition.
4. That no existing travel lanes or parking spaces shall be closed until authorized by the Director of Traffic and Parking.
5. That the contractor shall obtain a Temporary Street construction permit in addition to all other permits required by the City of Cambridge.
6. That the conditions having specified shall be subject to the approval of the Director of Traffic and Parking of the City of Cambridge, who may as he deems necessary, require traffic controls or the use of policemen to facilitate the flow of traffic.
7. The contractor to file with the City Clerk a bond in the sum of \$10,000.00 indemnifying the City of Cambridge from any liability that may arise from the construction of said barricade during the period of construction.
