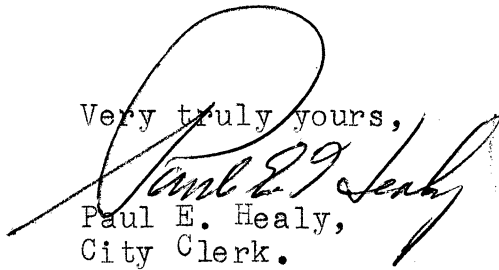

In amendment to an Ordinance, entitled: "General Ordinance of the City of Cambridge".

Be it ordained by the City Council of the City of Cambridge as follows:

Chapter 2, entitles: "Administration, Section 153A, a list of salaries of members of the Fire Department with amendments thereto is hereby further amended by striking out said Section 153A and substituting in place thereof the following new sections.

Section 153A: A list of salaries of the members of the Fire Department. The members of the Fire Department here-after named shall receive the following salaries, which are annual and are to be paid weekly.

Part #2 to be effective December 31, 1973

Fire Chief	\$26,490.00
Deputy Chiefs	\$20,936.00
Captains	\$17,975.00
Lieutenants	\$15,430.00
Privates Third Twelve months and thereafter	\$13,245.00
Privates Second Twelve months	\$11,747.00
Privates First Twelve months	\$10,251.00

Service under the provisions of this section relating to the Fire Department shall begin with the date of appointment and shall continue until his death, retirement or discharge.
