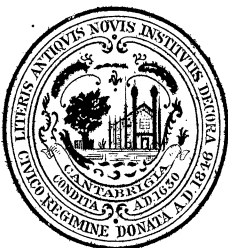

At a meeting of the Water Board held on the 24th day
of April, 1929, the following vote was passed:

VOTED: that in the opinion of the Water Board certain
land located on Lake View Avenue and Worthington Street, the same
being Lot 103 and Lot 99 on plan of the Coolidge Estate Lots in
Cambridge, Mass., Arthur Hodges, C. E. dated February 1886 and re-
corded in Middlesex South District, Registry of Deeds, Book of
Plans No 47 Plan 13, is no longer required for public purposes ex-
cept that a reservation should be made for the maintenance of a
water pipe as now exists therein, and that the clerk of the board
send notice of this vote to the City Council.

ORDERED:

That His Honor the Mayor be and hereby is authorized, in the name of, and in behalf of the City of Cambridge to sell and convey to Daniel Doyle for a sum not less than three thousand five hundred (3,500) dollars two parcels of land situated and described as follows:-

Parcel No. 1.

Beginning at a point in the westerly line of Lake View Avenue, said point being 34.6 feet distant southerly from the intersection of the southerly line of Worthington Street and the westerly line of Lake View Avenue, thence southerly along the westerly line of Lake View Avenue 60 ft. to a corner at land now or formerly of C. Bertram Crawford, thence westerly along land now or formerly of C. Bertram Crawford 153 feet to a corner at land of the City of Cambridge, thence northerly parallel to and 153 feet westerly from the westerly line of Lake View Avenue 60 feet along land of the City of Cambridge to a corner at other land of the City of Cambridge, thence easterly along land of said City of Cambridge 153 feet to the point of beginning. Containing 9,180 square feet more or less.

Parcel No. 2.

Beginning at a point in the westerly line of Lake View Avenue, at its intersection with the southerly line of Worthington Street, thence southerly along said westerly line of Lake View Avenue 34.6 feet more or less to a corner at land of the City of Cambridge, thence westerly parallel to and 34.6 feet distant southerly from the southerly line of Worthington Street 153 feet to land of the City of Cambridge, thence northerly along land of the City of Cambridge 34.6 feet to a corner in Worthington Street, thence easterly along said southerly line of Worthington Street 153 feet to the point of beginning. Containing 5,294 square feet more or less.
