AN ORDINANCE

In amendment to an Ordinance entitled: "The General Ordinances of the City of Cambridge."

Be it ordained by the City Council of the City of Cambridge as follows:

Article XXII, entitled: "Officers Generally," Section 2-191, List of Salaries in General is hereby amended by striking out said Section 2-191 and substituting in place thereof the following new sections.—

Section 2-191. List of Salaries in General.

(a) The officers of the City of Cambridge hereinafter named, shall receive the following salaries effective January 1, 1977.
