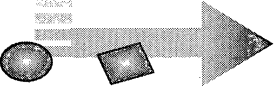

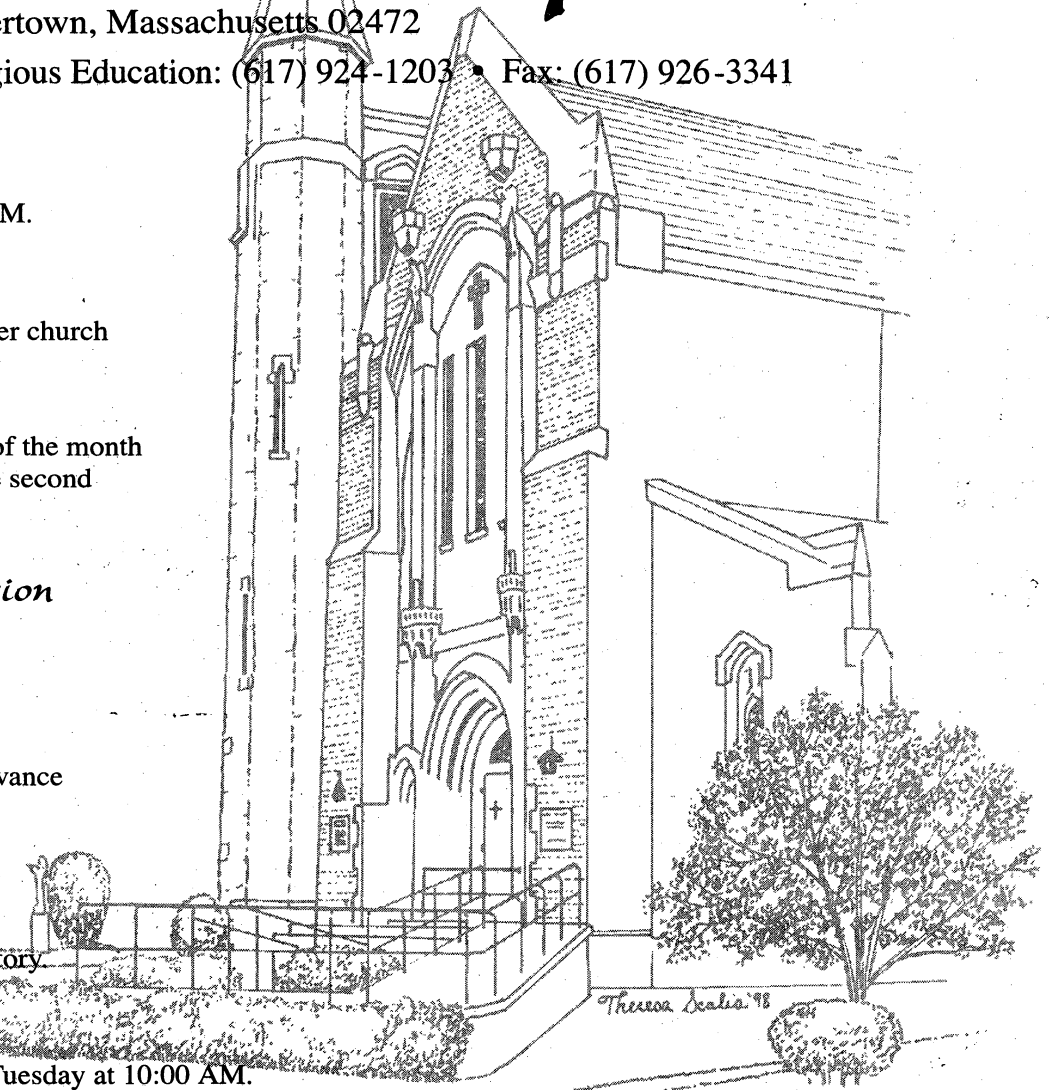

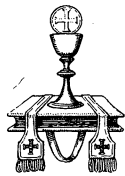

LENTEN REGULATIONS

ABSTINENCE from meat is to be observed by all Catholics 14 years of age and older on Good Friday and on all of the Fridays of Lent.

FASTING is to be observed on Good Friday by all Catholics who are 18 years of age up to age 60. Those who are bound by this may take only one full meal. Two smaller meals are permitted if necessary to maintain strength according to one's needs, but eating solid foods between meals is not permitted.

THE TRIDIUM – The holiest days of the church year are Holy Thursday, Good Friday and Holy Saturday. **Every Catholic**, without exception, is expected to take part in the liturgy on those days. These are our High Holy Days, and are more important than any other celebration of the year since they lead us to Easter – which we have preparing for since Ash Wednesday, and which we will celebrate until Pentecost Sunday. The services will take place at 8:00 p.m. each evening.

SR. MAY ON CONCERT – On Friday evening, May 11, there will be a concert by the musicians of Sacred Heart Parish: the Buckley Family, the Parish Choir, Jacques and Sylvia Bergeron – joined by the choir and orchestra of the Sisters of St. Joseph of Boston. This musical evening and the reception afterwards in McEntee Hall will raise funds for the memorial to St. Mary Ona Cahill who served our parish for 35 years before her sudden death on February 11. Sister was a member of the orchestra of the Sisters of St. Joseph for many years, and this concert will be a most appropriate remembrance. Tickets will be available beginning April 16 at the rectory during office hours and on the weekends in the vestibule of the church. The donation is \$15 per ticket.
