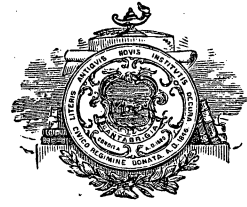

To the Honorable, the
Mayor and Aldermen:

around the Soldiers' Monument.
