- WHEREAS: Ray was a leading scorer for the Boston College Eagles Hockey Team in the early 1940's and continued his career in hockey after graduation, while playing semi-professional hockey with the old Boston Olympics; and
- WHEREAS: After retiring from his athletic career, Ray worked for Ginn and Company, a book publishing firm, for some twenty years until his retirement earlier this year; now therefore be it
- RESOLVED: That this City Council go on record extending its deepest sympathy to Mrs. Linda (Pressman) Chaisson and the Chaisson family at this time of such personal loss; and be it further
