- WHEREAS: The Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) Program has operated since 1974 to provide local governments with resources required to meet the needs of persons of low and moderate income; and
- WHEREAS: CDBG Program funds have been used by municipal department and non-profit corporations to provide essential community development, economic development, and human services to Cambridge residents through a broad range of programs and projects; and
- WHEREAS: Approximately 96 percent of the \$43,700.00 in Federal CDBG funds received has been expended for activities which principally benefit low and moderate income residents of Cambridge; and
- WHEREAS: The U.S. Conference of Mayors, National League of Cities, and National Community Development Association, with the participation of the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development, will observe April 2-9, 1988 as National Community Development Week; now therefore be it
- RESOLVED: That I, Alfred E. Vellucci, Mayor of the City of Cambridge, do hereby proclaim April 2-9, 1988 as Cambridge Community Development Week and urge all of our citizens to participate in ceremonies and activities celebrating this observance.
