To The Honorable, The City Council:

Attached is an order requesting a transfer of \$356,685.00 from the School Department Other Ordinary Maintenance Account and Extraordinary Expenditure Account to the School Department Salaries and Wages Account and Travel and Training Account in order to bring the City's statutory allocations in line with the budget adopted by the School Committee. At the time of the adoption of the budget, the School Committee had not yet given its approval to the final allocation of expenditures in the four statutory categories.
