US SPRINT

US Sprint has filed a tariff of rates and charges for the provision of operator services from pay telephones, hotels, motels, hospitals, universities and other traffic aggregators. In seeking to provide operator services to these types of locations, US Sprint also requests to be exempted from complying with requirements imposed on alternative operator service providers.

The above investigation is officially captioned:

Investigation by the Department on its own motion as to the propriety of the rates and charges set forth in the following tariff: M.D.P.U. No. 2, Table of Contents, 19th Revised Page 1, 1st Revised Page 10.1, 1st Revised Page 27.1.1 and 1st Revised Page 30.2.1, filed with the Department on April 17, 1990 to become effective May 16, 1990 by US Sprint Communications Company Limited Partnership.

The Department of Public Utilities will conduct a public hearing on the above matter at its hearing room, Leverett Saltonstall Building, 100 Cambridge Street, Boston, Massachusetts on Tuesday, July 17, 1990 at 10:00 a.m.

The petitioner is required to give notice of said hearing by publication hereof once, at least twenty-one days prior to the date of the hearing in the Boston Globe, The Morning Union (Springfield), the Berkshire Eagle (Pittsfield) and The Evening Gazette (Worcester), and to serve a copy hereof no later than twenty-one (21) days prior to said date to the parties on the attached list.
