The Joint Committee on Roads & Bridges to whom were referred the petitions of John F. Mead and others for the acceptance of Snow Street and of Wm. Cooper and others for the acceptance of Fremont Street have considered the same and respectfully report.

The Committee recommend that when the petitioners furnish a plan, embracing both streets showing them each to be thirty feet in width and free from all encumbrances, the two streets be accepted and laid out as one under the name of Fremont Street.
