Early in 2000, we held a public hearing on the proposed conversion of the Cambridgeport Bank from a depositor-owned to stockholder-controlled institution – with specific attention to concerns about continuing ties to the Cambridge community and continued commitment to the needs of the owners of the bank for decades, the depositors.

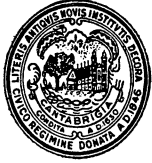
Based on publicly available info, below is a brief update on the bank since its change in status was approved last year:

Cambridgeport Bank, formerly a local Cambridge mutual bank, is now known as Port Financial Corp.

The bank is no longer headquartered in Cambridge, where it was based since its founding in 1853, but at 1380 Soldiers Field Road, Brighton, MA 02135 (Phone: (617) 661-4900; Fax: (617) 779-4000)

It is now a publicly traded stock company following its conversion from a mutual in April 2000.

A majority of the stock of Port Financial, 52%, has been bought by institutions as of December 20, 2000. None of these institutional owners are based in Cambridge, and most are out-of-state. Before its
