- WHEREAS: John, the son of a well-known Cambridge family, was a graduate of Malden Catholic High School, Saint Anselm's College in New Hampshire where he obtained his Bachelors Degree and he later received a Master in Education Degree from Boston State College; and
- WHEREAS: John first entered the Cambridge School System as a teacher upon graduation from St. Anselm's and taught in several schools during his twenty-three year career, a career which saw John's interest in children grow as he coached both basketball and baseball, an interest he held from his days in the Cambridge Recreation Department; and
- WHEREAS: Although John's short life came to a close on March 21, 1982 after battling cancer for some time, John will be remembered by his family, colleagues and students as a loving husband and father, a tower of strength and guiding force by those who knew him in the past and will remember him in the future; now therefore be it
