IN CITY COUNCIL

ORDERED:

That, in accordance with Massachusetts General Laws, Chapter 44, Section 53A, the City Council approves the acceptance of a gift of Two Thousand Dollars (\$2,000.00) to establish the Cambridge Field Branch Library Fund to be used by the Cambridge Public Library for the following purposes:

To purchase library materials to expand and round out the existing Cambridge Field Branch Library's holdings.

To make improvements beyond the scope of the regular replacement/maintenance budget of the Cambridge Field Branch Library.

To fund special projects enabling the Branch Library to better serve the residents of the neighboring community.

At the request of the donor who wishes to remain anonymous, the fund is to be used at the discretion of the Director of the Cambridge Public Library and the principal is to be used, if necessary, thereby not restricting the library to the use of the interest derived from the principal.

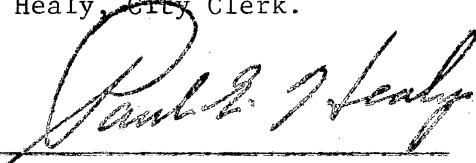

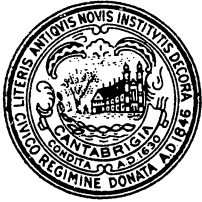
