In Board of Aldermen, Nov. 20. 1851.

Ordered, That due notice be given that it is the intention of this Board to lay out a new street in Ward One, from Vassall Lane to Brattle Street; the same to be laid out from a point in Vassall Lane, opposite the end of Warden Street, over a private street leading over lands of Charles C. Little and William L. Stearns, by the Reservoir of the Cambridge Water Works, thence to Fayerweather Street, so called, and thence over said Fayerweather Street to Brattle Street; and that any and all persons interested in the question of said laying out, may appear and be heard at the regular meeting of this Board, to be held on Wednesday, the fourth day of December next, at 10 o'clock, A.M.
