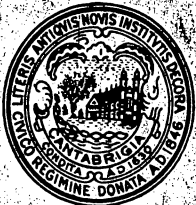

The Law Department, under the provisions of General Laws, Chapter 41, Section 100-A, defended an action against William R. Walsh, in which there was a judgment of \$463.16.

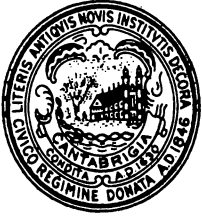


