In answer to a City Council Order of October 15, 1973 regarding the expansion of the Resident Sticker Program, I wish to inform you that I am prepared to institute this program in the following areas of the City.

1. EAST CAMBRIDGE: The area bounded by Cambridge Street, Third Street, Charles St., and Fulkerson Street.
2. RIVERSIDE AREA: The area bounded by Putnam Avenue, Franklin Street and Western Avenue.
3. Expansion of the Brattle Street - Mt. Auburn Street Area to include Berkeley Street, Phillips Place, Craigie Street, Concord Avenue from Garden Street to Waterhouse Street, Follen Street and Waterhouse Street.

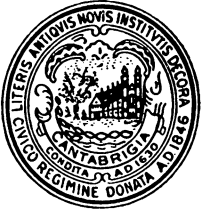
The implementation of this program in these areas will depend on my request for funds requested from the Parking Fund.

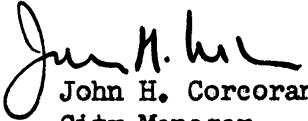
