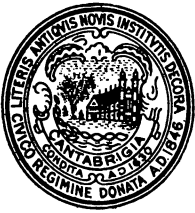

I hereby request an appropriation in the amount of \$127.53 to reimburse Edward R. Baldasaro, an employee of the Public Works Department for damages in this amount.

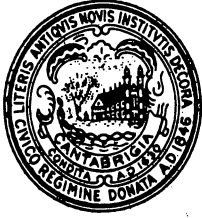
