It was with profound sorrow that this City Council learned of the passing of Albert T. Doyle at the age of eighty-five years on July 10, 1974, after a long illness, and

WHEREAS:

Albert T. Doyle was a career man in the City Government who served his native city for forty-four years from 1914 until his retirement in 1958, and

WHEREAS:

Albert T. Doyle was recognized as an expert on municipal law who rendered invaluable advice to the City Council of Cambridge in his capacity as Assistant City Clerk from 1936 until 1958 and was an authority on the conduct of the City Government under the Plan E Charter, and

WHEREAS:

Albert T. Doyle was an active member of the Massachusetts and Cambridge Bar Association, a director of the Reliance Cooperative Bank and a past President of the City Clerk's Association of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts, and

WHEREAS:

On the passing of Albert T. Doyle the City of Cambridge has lost a dedicated and loyal public official who served as City Clerk and Clerk of the City Council on many occasions and won the admiration of his associates for his conduct of that office, therefore be it

RESOLVED:

That the Mayor and this City Council of the City of Cambridge on this ninth day of September, 1974 recognizing the profound influence of Albert T. Doyle on the civic life of Cambridge, does hereby adjourn the meeting in honor and memory of Albert T. Doyle, and be it further

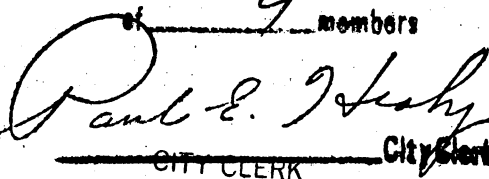
