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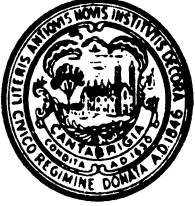

To The Honorable, The City Council:

I am hereby requesting an appropriation of \$159,236.00 in the Grant Fund of the Human Services Salary and Wages Account (\$156,935.00), Other Ordinary Maintenance Account (\$1,501.00) and Travel and Training Account (\$800.00). The HIP program was created when the State combined the Housing Search Program and the Housing Services Program into the Homeless Intercept Program under EOCD. The Massachusetts Department of Community Development has awarded these funds to be used to prevent homelessness by providing counseling for tenants and landlords, mediation for disputes between tenants and landlords, and housing search assistance for families facing eviction. The funds will be used to cover the salaries of three caseworkers as well as program costs and training.
