MAYOR WOLF

- WHEREAS: Massachusetts produces six and a half million tons of solid waste every year yet recycles only about 7%; and
- WHEREAS: The traditional "burn and bury" methods of trash disposal have contaminated drinking water supplies, polluted the air, and depleted our natural resources; and
- WHEREAS: The Recycling Initiative would promote solid waste reduction and recycling by requiring that, by 1996, all packaging used in Massachusetts be either reusable or made of recycled or recyclable materials; therefore, be it
- RESOLVED: That this City Council endorses the RECYCLING INITIATIVE in order to protect the quality of Massachusetts' water and air, preserve natural resources, and save millions of tax dollars now wasted on garbage disposal by making reduction and recycling the priorities in the state for dealing with solid waste; and be it further
- RESOLVED: That this City Council strongly urge other individuals and organizations to endorse the RECYCLING INITIATIVE.
