MAYOR WOLF

WHEREAS: Many Cambridge parents have come to rely on afterschool child care services and programs for their Cambridge Public School children; and

WHEREAS: It is critical that afterschool programs coordinate with regular school programs so that parents can make school choices and afterschool care in tandem; and

WHEREAS: The Department of Human Service Programs, as well as other child care programs using the schools, and the School Department must together effectuate such a system; now therefore be it

ORDERED: That the City Manager be and hereby is requested to request the Assistant City Manager of Human Services to work with the Superintendent of Schools and the directors of other school-based afterschool programs to:

- (1) define the issues that must be resolved to provide integrated school/child care services
- (2) resolve as many of these issues as possible before complications develop for next school year, especially for incoming kindergarten children, and
- (3) plan for long-term solutions to all these issues; and be it further

ORDERED: That these parties feel free to utilize the good offices of the City Manager and the Mayor to assist in this collaboration.
