- WHEREAS: Rose, after graduating from Cambridge High and Latin School in 1940, continued her education with a B.S. in Education from Salem State College in 1944 and a Masters in Guidance and Personell from Boston University in 1953; and
- WHEREAS: Rose came to the Cambridge School Department in 1969 as an Administrative Assistant and was appointed Administrative Assistant to the Superintendent in 1976; and
- WHEREAS: Rose has been invaluable in developing projects that include the teacher orientation program, the teacher evaluation program, the Grant Management Program, Project Business, and Mass Pep; and
- WHEREAS: Rose was instrumental in securing federal funds for the Cambridge School Department in conjunction with the Title I, Title II, Title IV-C and Follow Through programs; and
- WHEREAS: Rose was the first person to develop an affirmative action plan for the Cambridge School Department as well as help get funding for the desegregation program; and
- WHEREAS: Rose has represented the School Department as a liaison to Speaker Tip O'Neill's office and as a representative to the Cambridge Chamber of Commerce; now therefore be it
- RESOLVED: That this City Council go on record extending its congratulations to Rose O'Rourke upon her retirement from the Cambridge School Department, extend to her its sincerest appreciation for the time and committment she has given, and wish her the best of luck in her upcoming career in real estate.
