Joseph H. Kozlowsky was a graduate of Cambridge High and Latin School in 1920 and a member of the class of 1925 at Boston College where he gained All American recognition as Captain of the Boston College football team and was instrumental with the late John J. Sheehan, Head Master of Cambridge High and Latin School, in achieving national recognition for the Maroon and Gold under the direction of the late Frank J. Cavanaugh, and

Joseph H. Kozlowsky was appointed a teacher in the Cambridge School System in 1929 and was an outstanding Basketball Coach at Cambridge High and Latin School and continued his deep interest in the field of athletics leading to his eventual appointment as Director of Physical Education in 1954, and

His passing will be sorely felt by the members of his family, and his many friends and associates who remembered him for his genial disposition and courteous manner, therefore be it

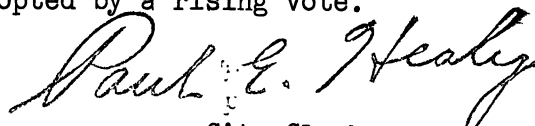
RESOLVED:-
