Dear Sir. The City Engineer has prepared a plan shewing a proposed widening of Steward St. by taking of land of Harvard University in exchange for land contained in Holmes' Square.

There is reason to believe that the College authorities will favorably consider such a proposition, and I recommend your Committee to confer with the Bureau, Mr. Danforth, at an early day, to whom it may be well to exhibit the plan before named.

It is desirable to secure 13 ft. additional width, that the street may be made 70 ft wide.
