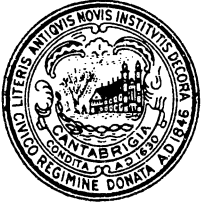

To the Honorable, the City Council:

Contractual agreements with City employees negotiated by the previous administration stipulate a cost-of-living adjustment based upon the percentage increase in the Consumer Price Index between January 1973 and July 1974, as computed by the Department of Labor. As you are well aware, the eighteen-month period in question was one of extraordinary inflationary pressures.

The practical and painful result of these agreements at this juncture is an obligation by the City to increase employee pay scales by an incredible 15.6%. By terms of these contracts increases must be applied retroactively to July 1, 1974.

Based upon these new figures, the present Salary Adjustments account of \$3,000,000 is substantially underfunded. While a projection of this deficit runs as high as \$1,000,000, I am hereby respectfully requesting an additional appropriation to this account in the amount of \$775,000 to be included in the current fiscal year's tax levy. Use of close analysis and strict budgetary controls should enable us to meet our obligations with this lesser additional appropriation.
