To The Honorable, The City Council:

I am hereby requesting the appropriation of \$7,859.00 in the Grant Fund of the Department of Human Services Salary and Wages Account (\$1,335.00) and Other Ordinary Maintenance Account (\$6,524.00) from the Massachusetts Housing & Shelter Alliance (MHSA). This appropriation represents an increase in the total award for this year from \$78,592 to \$86,451. MHSA funds are used to provide services to homeless persons residing at the Cambridge YMCA and YWCA. The funding supports two full-time positions at the Multi-Service Center, as well as a portion of our contract with Federated Dorchester Neighborhood Houses (d/b/a/ Kit Clark) for housing search & stabilization services, and a technical assistance contract with CASPAR. The additional funding will be used for additional technical assistance from CASPAR, client transportation, and administrative costs.
