- WHEREAS: John served his country well during World War II as a member of the United States Navy and upon being honorably discharged became an active member of the North Cambridge Veterans of Foreign Wars Post 7353; and
- WHEREAS: John worked for many years for the Cambridge Water Department and held the position of Foreman at the time of his death, a position he attained through promotional examination, and in fact, served as an Advisor to the Division of Personnel Administration, establishing criteria for written examinations for various labor service positions relating to Water Department functions; now therefore be it
