- WHEREAS:** It has come to the attention of this City Council that during the 1982 Annual Recognition Dinner sponsored by the President of Northeastern University, a former Cambridge native, Allen R. Sullivan was honored as one of six outstanding alumni of the university, men and women who through dedicated service to their professions, volunteer service to the community and dedication to the university through generous financial support, bring honor upon themselves and upon the university; and
- WHEREAS:** Allen R. Sullivan, a native Cantabrigian whose family have long been residents and active in our community, received his Bachelors Science Degree in Education in 1965 from Northeastern University and went on to earn both a Masters in Science and a Ph.D in Special Education from Syracuse University; and
- WHEREAS:** Dr. Sullivan is currently Assistant Superintendent of Schools in Dallas, Texas and serves as a consultant to over forty educational institutions around the country and has published extensively in professional journals and in 1972 was appointed by Minnesota's Governor Wendell Anderson to the Governor's Advisory Board for Handicapped, Gifted and Exceptional Children; now therefore be it
