- WHEREAS: Many young people are often attracted to illegal drugs through the ready availability and open display of drug paraphernalia; and
- WHEREAS: An industry has developed which promotes the illegal use of drugs by children as well as adults, an industry which has mushroomed into a multi-million dollar business; and
- WHEREAS: Recently announced federal statistics indicate the percentage of drug users is rapidly rising with four out of every ten people in the age bracket of twelve to twenty-five using some kind of drug; now therefore be it
- RESOLVED: That this City Council go on record in support of House Bill #6661 the same being An Act Prohibiting the Sale of Drug Paraphernalia; and be it further
