Subject Parking Fines

At the City Council Finance Committee's budget hearing it was suggested by the councilors that I increase the established penalties for illegal parkers in the City of Cambridge. It was also suggested that I use my own judgment as to what areas to increase the fines. The two areas that the councilors suggested were meter violations and restricted areas (loading zones).

I have therefore studied the fines and respectfully request that the enclosed proposed new fine schedule be given to the City Council for their information.

The new fine schedule will go into effect on, or about July 15, 1981 as we must print new parking tags along with using up the old parking tags in stock and the legal advertisements that are necessary to promulgate any new regulation.

Also enclosed is a copy of the existing fine schedule.

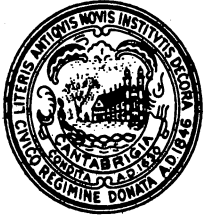
