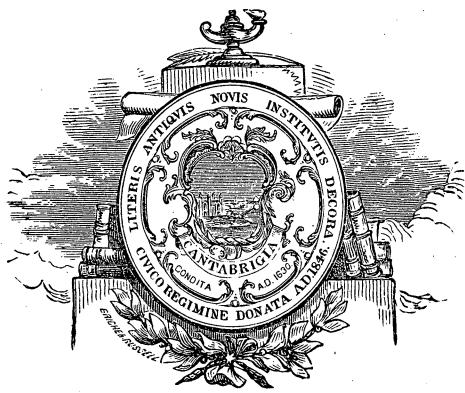




CITY OF CAMBRIDGE.

IN BOARD OF ALDERMEN,

Dec. 22 1886.

WHEREAS: It is adjudged by this Board that the public necessity and convenience require that *Kinnaird Street, so-called, extending from River street to Western Avenue,*

should be laid out as a public Street. Ordered that a strip of land *forty feet,* in width between *River street and Western Avenue*

included between the *black* lines as shown on a plan drawn by *W. A. Mason* and *Son, Surveyors, dated December 1. 1886*

and now before this Board, be taken for public use and laid out as a public Street.

Ordered that *no* damages be allowed for the land so taken as aforesaid, *the several owners of lands abutting on said street, having waived the usual notice, and agreed to make no claim on account of such taking.*
