To the Honorable Mayor and Aldermen
of the City of Cambridge.

The petitioner respectfully represents that he has caused a two inch plank sidewalk to be put down on Inman St between Harvard St and the land occupied by the Harvard Grammar School (at the corner of Broadway Inman St.) the expense of which is as follows

1779 Ft Plank @ \$17. \$30.24

38" Nails 5¢ 1.90

5 Day Labor 17.50 \$49.64

and requests that he may be reimbursed that amount by the City for the following reasons.

1st Inman St. between Harvard St & Broadway has now been accepted by the City. all other parts of the said street have been accepted and brick sidewalks have been laid. the sidewalks between Harvard St & Broadway have for years been in a very bad condition

2nd The city have entered upon an unaccepted street and built a school house one of the principal approaches to which is through said part of the street, where at least three hundred children pass four times a day, and no suitable sidewalk has been provided for them now.

3^d Broadway Inman St is the terminus of a line of horse cars, passengers arriving from Boston who go to Harvard and many other streets are obliged to pass through said part of Inman St. to their great discomfort.
