- WHEREAS: The City Council is in receipt of a letter from a number of abutters and residents calling attention to the public health hazard in the issuance of this curb cut; and
- WHEREAS: These neighbors have voiced these objection to the City Council's action; and
- WHEREAS: A recently enacted city ordinance which changes the setback and lot requirements for parking spaces may be an issue in this case; therefore be it
- RESOLVED: That the City Council immediately hear the objections of the petitioners to this curb cut; and be it further
- RESOLVED: That the City Council rescind its action of June 8, 1981 granting a curb cut at 28 Maple Avenue.
