Subject: Council Order #54, Dated 8/3/92

Re: **The status of recycling in residential buildings with 13 or more units.**

The multi-family dwelling recycling program is well underway. This past May owners and managers of buildings with 13 or more units were mailed the "Guide to Preparing Recycling Plans for Multi-Family Dwellings". An informational workshop was held on July 16 to address concerns of owners and managers.

The recycling staff has established the goal of implementing recycling programs in all large buildings (approx. 220 buildings) receiving City trash service by June 30, 1993. Recycling programs in the 120 buildings with private trash collection will be implemented starting in Fiscal Year 1994. As of mid-September, 3,220 households in 75 large buildings have access to recycling programs in their buildings. This includes two Cambridge Housing Authority developments -- River Howard Homes and Washington Elms.

Adopted by the affirmative vote of nine members.

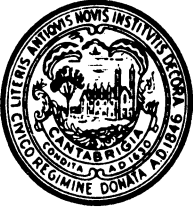

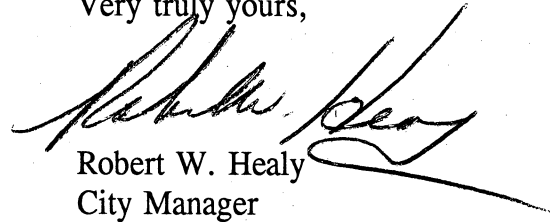
