To The Honorable, The City Council:

Attached is an order requesting the appropriation of \$18,324.00 in the grant fund from the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) through the United Way to the Human Service's Other Ordinary Maintenance Account to provide funds for purchasing emergency food and shelter and to supplement and extend current available emergency resources. Contract funds will be spent in three areas; \$11,324.00 will be subcontracted to the YMCA for emergency resident rooms, \$2,000.00 will be used to supplement the fund for housing the homeless by providing rental assistance to those seeking permanent/transitional housing and \$5,000.00 will be used by the fuel Assistance Program to augment their available resources.

Passage of this order is recommended.
