NuComm Test, Inc. ("NuComm" or "Company"), a Delaware corporation has applied to the Department of Public Utilities to provide telephone service within the Commonwealth of Massachusetts. The Company proposes to provide point-to-point telecommunications services to business users, via fiber optic and coaxial cables. The services proposed include: high capacity digital private lines (DS-1 and DS-3 duplex transmission paths) between business customer locations. Also, the Company intends to develop and offer special services, which may include voice, data, or video. The Company intends to use its own facilities in combination with leased facilities from other fiber carriers and cable operators.

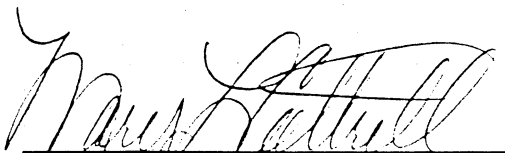

Application of NuComm Test, Inc., under the provisions of Chapter 159 of the General Laws as amended, for a certificate of public convenience and necessity to operate as a resale, value-added or interexchange common carrier within the Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

Comments, objections and requests for a public hearing on the proposed service must be made in writing with specific reasons for requesting a public hearing, and filed with the Secretary of the Department on or before November 27, 1992.

The petitioner, NuComm, is required to give notice by publications hereof once, in the Boston Globe, the Boston Herald, the Morning Union (Springfield), the Berkshire Eagle (Pittsfield) and the Worcester Telegram, and to serve a copy hereof at least twenty-one (21) days prior to said date [November 20, 1992], on the attached list, and to make return of service and publication no later than November 27, 1992.
