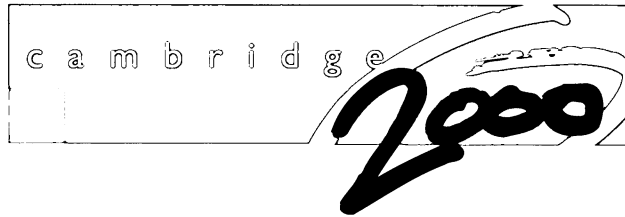

To the Honorable, the City Council:

I am hereby requesting the appropriation of \$95,000 in the Public Investment Fund Public Works Department Extraordinary Expenditure Account from property taxes.

The City is contracting with David Perry Architects to oversee the structural decontamination work at 57 Inman Street and to carry out initial design work for the building. David Perry Architects will be working with a team to include MacRichie Engineering (HVAC Engineer), Clayton Group Services (Industrial Hygienist), Hanscomb Associates (cost estimators) and Chaloff Engineering (structural engineer)

The contract will be carried out in two phases. The first phase is for the structural decontamination of the building. This involves ensuring that all necessary environmental tests have been completed, reviewing the structural decontamination specifications, preparing the bid documents, and overseeing the decontamination work. The second phase involves development of at least two conceptual designs for reconstructing the 57 Inman Street building. While completing this work, the architect will meet representatives of the effected departments.

This contract should be completed within 3 months. Based on the recommendations of the architectural team, I will be making further funding requests for the actual decontamination and reconstruction of the building.
