In Board of Aldermen, February 9, 1886.

Ordered, That the residents on Brattle Street and streets in its vicinity be and they are hereby granted permission to lay ^{and maintain} a plank walk on the northerly side of said Brattle Street, from Sparks Street to Oakview Avenue; said plank walk to be constructed in conformity to a plan in the office of the City Engineer, and to be annually lifted and stored in the spring and relaid in the autumn, by the Superintendent of Streets under direction of the Standing Committee on Roads and Bridges of the Board of Aldermen, and at all times to be kept in proper repair by the abutters.

Amended, by striking in - the para enclosed in brackets, and inserting in place thereof the words "and in conformity with the provisions of the Ordinance relating to Plank walks."

As amended, adopted.
