SUBJECT: STATUS REPORT ON CAMBRIDGE HOME RULE LEGISLATION

Representative Tim Toomey, through his assistant Jay Kiely, has provided the following update on the status of Cambridge home rule legislation:

1. H4777. Cambridge's home rule petition entitled **AN ACT TO PERMIT THE CITY OF CAMBRIDGE TO EXEMPT CERTAIN INCOME PRODUCING ASSETS FROM THE ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS TO AN ELDERLY ABATEMENT** has been assigned a number, H4777, and referred to the Committee on Taxation, chaired by Representative Angelo M. Scaccia. A hearing has been scheduled for April 14, 1993 at 11:30 a.m. in Room A1.

2. House Docket No. 4947. Cambridge's petition entitled **AN ACT RELATIVE TO LICENSING CERTAIN MOTOR CARRIERS IN THE CITY OF CAMBRIDGE** has been assigned a docket number. It was initially being held in the Rules Committee on account of concerns relating to its constitutionality, but it has now been referred to the Government Relations Committee.

Jay Kiely indicated that the bill went to the Rules Committee automatically as a late-filed bill and is presently being held there on account of concerns relating to constitutionality.
