The present design includes the beginning of the Inner Belt through Cambridge, and

WHEREAS:-

The Mayor and citizens of Somerville have supported the City of Cambridge in its fight against the Inner Belt, now therefore be it

That this City Council is in support of the request of said Somerville citizens and officials for a redesign of I93 through Somerville and that this resolve be forwarded to Governor Sargent and Mayor Lester Ralph of Somerville.
