RESOLVE PROVIDING FOR AN INVESTIGATION AND STUDY BY A SPECIAL COMMISSION
RELATIVE TO PRACTICES OF DEVELOPERS OF HIGH-RISE PROJECTS IN CITIES AND TOWNS OF
THE COMMONWEALTH AND ANY OTHER RELATED MATTERS.

RESOLVED, That a special commission, to consist of two members of
the senate, three members of the house of representatives, the commissioner of
public safety or his designee, the commissioner of public health or his designee,
and two persons to be appointed by the governor, is hereby established for the
purpose of making an investigation and study relative to practices of developers
of high-rise projects in cities and towns of the commonwealth and any other related
matters.
